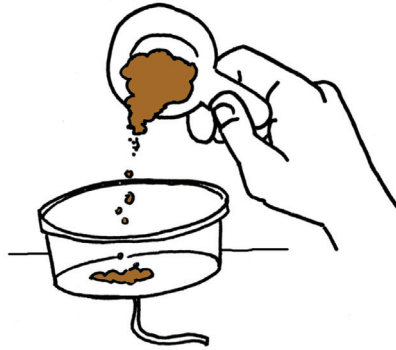
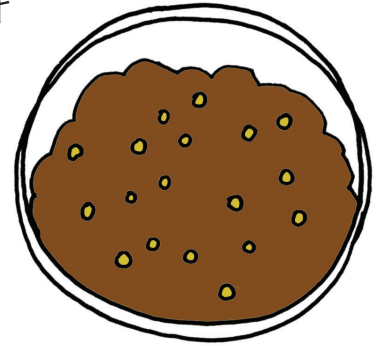


Seed Disk Planting Instructions

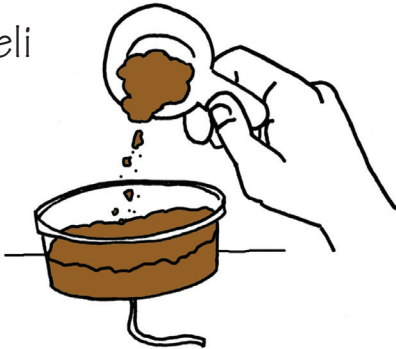
1. Push a wick through a hole in the bottom of a small deli container. Add $\frac{1}{2}$ cup potting mix.



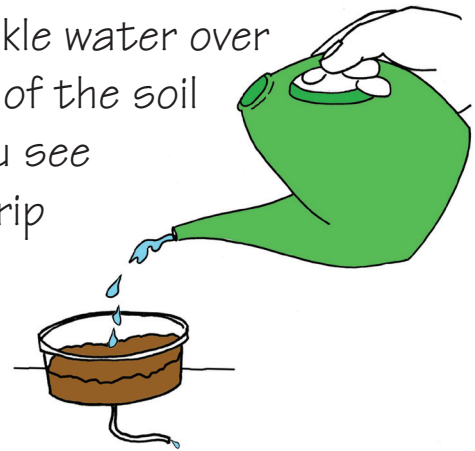
2. Spread 18 pellets of fertilizer on top of the potting mix.



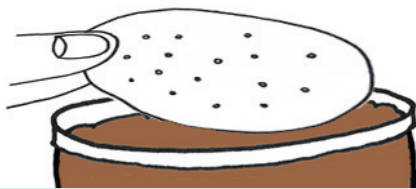
3. Pour another $\frac{1}{2}$ cup potting mix into the small deli container.



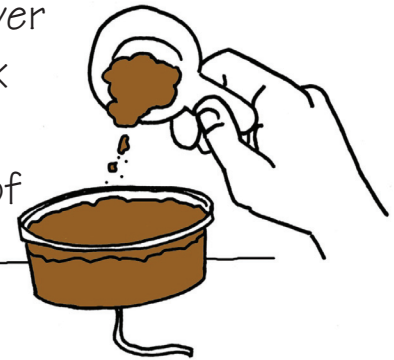
4. Sprinkle water over the top of the soil until you see water drip from the wick.



5. Place one seed disk on top of the potting mix.



6. Lightly cover the seed disk with no more than $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of potting mix.



7. Pour water into a large deli container that will become the water reservoir. Put together your growing system with the wick floating in the water reservoir.



8. Gently water the top of the soil covering your seed disk.
